FORENSICS TALENT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

The Wayne State University Talent Scholarship program is designed to recognize high school seniors or recent graduates with talent in **FORENSICS**. These scholarships are based on an evaluation of the talent of individual students by Wayne State University faculty and provide funds approximately equal to half of the cost of in-state tuition. The determination of the awards is strictly the decision of Wayne State University.

Scholarship Deadline: Friday, January 20, 2017

TO BE ELIGIBLE:

- You must be a high school senior or recent graduate.
- You must fulfill admission requirements to Wayne State University.
- You may be awarded a scholarship in only one talent area.

AWARD TERMS:

- The talent scholarship is available for eight consecutive academic terms or until you obtain the baccalaureate degree, whichever comes first, as long as you maintain good academic standing and meet the performance standards set by the department.
- You must participate actively in the Forensics program.
- You must attend full time (12-16 credit hours) during the Fall and Winter terms. (Spring/Summer terms excluded.)
