Announcement and Guidelines

Nomination Deadline **EXTENDED Monday, March 6, 2017**

The Teaching Award recognizes exemplary teaching with an emphasis on extraordinary efforts that enrich our educational environment.

Up to two awards are available, each for \$500, for full-time faculty members currently employed in the College of Fine, Performing and Communication Arts.

Nomination Process and Deadline Nominations will be accepted from individual students, student groups, faculty or staff within CFPCA until **Monday, February 27, 2017**. No self-nominations will be accepted. The nomination form is an interactive PDF and can be downloaded from the College web site under “Awards and Scholarships” on the “Current Students” and “Faculty and Staff” pages. Group nominations should indicate a main contact person and list the names of all group members at the end of the Nomination Statement. A worksheet for the form is attached to this announcement.

Selection Nominees will be notified and asked to provide the following by **Monday, March 20, 2017**.

1. A brief teaching philosophy statement including discussion of innovative techniques and special efforts
2. A summary of up to three years’ Student Evaluation of Teaching scores with a brief introduction highlighting accomplishments and innovations indicative of the nominee’s teaching successes
3. A copy of his/her current WSU Professional Record

All nominations will be evaluated by the College Faculty Council which will make recommendations to the Dean. The Dean will announce and present the awards at the Spring Faculty Assembly.

Awardees will be notified in early-April 2017.
