Made In Detroit Scholarship

The CFPCA Made In Detroit Scholarship has been established to recognize scholastic achievement, to encourage continued progress, and to provide assistance to students in financing their education in the Department of Music.

Eligibility:

1. All currently enrolled full-time or part-time undergraduate and graduate students are eligible. However, students majoring in music will be given preference.
2. Recipients must be residents of the state of Michigan.
3. A minimum GPA is not required.
4. Applicants must include Academics financial aid statement showing current financial need.

Application Procedure:

Complete the CFPCA application in AcademicWorks and submit a statement describing your financial need, your estimation of your scholarly work as a student and an outline of your reasons for requesting this award.

Funding Available:

One grant annually will be awarded in the range of \$500 - \$750. The grant will be disbursed through Financial Aid.

Deadline: March 1

Applications will be reviewed by the CFPCA Scholarship Committee.
