Annetta Miller Endowed Scholarship

The Annetta Miller Endowed Scholarship has been established to recognize scholastic achievement, to encourage continued progress in the education of students in the College of Fine, Performing and Communication Arts at Wayne State University.

Eligibility:

1. All currently enrolled full-time or part-time undergraduate or graduate students with majors in the College of Fine, Performing and Communication Arts who are in good academic standing may apply.
2. Students must be enrolled during the period covered by the requested funding.

Application Procedure:

Complete the CFPCA application in AcademicWorks and submit a statement containing your honest estimation of your scholarly work so far at WSU, your financial situation, an explanation of your reasons for requesting this award, and when you plan to graduate.

Funding Available:

One grant per year will be awarded in the range of \$750. Grants will be disbursed through Financial Aid.

Deadline: March 1

Applications will be reviewed by the CFPCA Scholarship Committee.
